We just wanted to say thank you and to give you an update of where we are and how things are going. My condition is deteriorating and Sue and I do have much difficulty in coming to terms with what lies ahead.

We have sold our house in Baldivis and are living in a townhouse in Bicton which is closer to doctors, hospital and other support. We are renovating the downstairs of the unit to allow me to live on the ground floor and have wheelchair access when the time comes.

My hands have continued to weaken and I am now having difficulty breathing at night and have to sleep hooked up to a machine which helps force air into my lungs while I am asleep. I also get very tired by the end of the day and energy levels are low!

The Motor Neurone Disease help group in Australia have been fantastic and are a wonderful source of information and support to both of us.

We had a wonderful trip to South Africa and thank you to all of you who made this possible – It was great to see some of you and we were just sorry that we could not see everyone.
